## ORDER AMENDING DRESS CODE UNTIL OCTOBER 1, 2018

It is AGREED and hereby ORDERED by the undersigned judges of the County Criminal Courts at Law of Harris County, Texas, THAT:

We suspend the requirement for male attorneys to wear coat and tie, instead requesting a collared shirt and slacks, with comparable attire for the female attorneys, when they attend our bond docket courtrooms in the Family Law Center. This rule shall take effect May 21, 2018 and remain in effect until October 1, 2018, and shall apply to the bond docket courtrooms of all of the undersigned judges.
